

Night Bazaar Guided Tour

Understanding the contextual factors contributing to oppression and deprivation is essential for social workers. A group of thirty-eight social work students, from full-time and part-time modes of Associate of Social Science in Social Work, participated in the guided tour visiting the Shum Shui Po Night Bazaar. Through the visiting and meeting with stakeholders, students gained a better and deeper understanding of underprivileged citizens and the process of empowerment.
