Public History

This undergraduate public history programme, the first of its kind in Hong Kong, aims to equip students with the knowledge and passion to engage in the needs of Hong Kong society, whether in public service, cultural heritage, or business venture. The programme has the following main features.

First, it offers training that puts history to practical use, such as cultural tourism, heritage preservation, historic sites and community history research, museum exhibitions, etc. This programme distinguishes itself from current cultural management programmes by its emphasis on solid training in historical methods and knowledge. Second, it emphasizes experiential learning that moves beyond the classroom. Learning activities designed in this programme include but not limited to historic site and museum visits, community-based research projects, use of new communication technology in understanding history and promoting heritage, etc. Third, it offers training in museum and heritage studies, film and documentary analysis, monuments and architecture. Students will acquire interdisciplinary knowledge and skills regarding the interpretation and presentation of the past in various forms. Fourth, the programme is both interdisciplinary and cross-cultural. Students will be introduced to case studies around the world, which will prepare them to engage both locally and globally.


Society and Sustainable Development



Society and Sustainable Development (SSD) is a transdisciplinary stream for Non-JUPAS Senior Year Admission under the Sociology Programme, in collaboration with the Earth System Science Programme and the Gender Studies Programme. The innovative curriculum of SSD offers students theorization and advanced methods drawn from social sciences and science in the study of key challenges in sustainable development. These complex issues, such as inequality and poverty, global environmental change, diversity and gender equality, require knowledge input from multi-disciplines.


SSD will equip you with a solid foundation and training in research methodologies, including qualitative approaches for social assessment and computational methods for data analysis. Students can choose to pursue specializations. Graduates can either study further in the field of sustainability, or embark on careers in the rapidly expanding job sectors within the region: project coordinators in social and environmental NGOs, corporate sustainability / ethical / diversity specialists overseeing environment and social governance (ESG), consultants for carbon management and auditing, green and sustainable finance analysts, policy analysts in think tanks, and the governments.

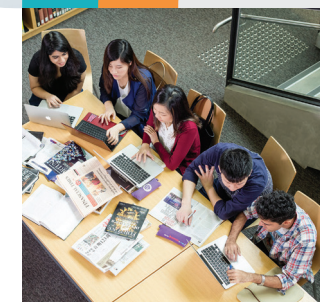
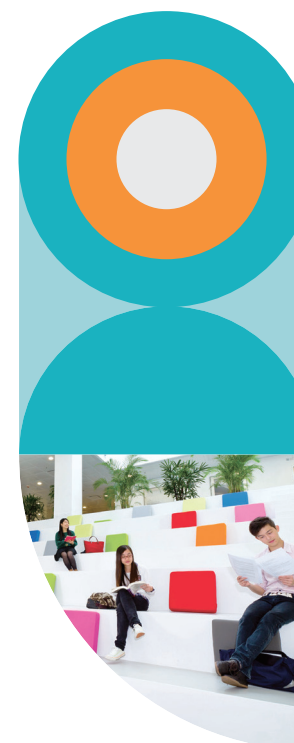

Remarks:

- (#1) 2-year curriculum
- (#2) **Japanese Studies:** Knowledge of Chinese characters or Japanese "Kanji" will facilitate language study in the programme. For Senior Year Entry, students are required to possess Japanese Language Proficiency Test (N2) level at the time of admission.
Economics (Dual Degree Programme with Tsinghua University): Applicable for holders of Hong Kong Identity Card and Mainland Travel Permit for Hong Kong and Macau Residents. Applicants will be automatically considered for the respective major programme (Economics) if they are not offered by the Dual Degree Programme.
Natural Sciences: Students have to indicate the concentration areas in a priority order which include Chemical and Testing Sciences, Biological Sciences, Biotechnology, Data Science, Environmental Studies, Food and Nutrition, Physical Sciences.
Science: Broad-based admission designed for students interested in pursuing a major in one of the following subjects: Biochemistry, Biology, Cell and Molecular Biology, Chemistry, Earth and Environmental Sciences, Food and Nutritional Sciences, Mathematics, Molecular Biotechnology, Physics, Statistics. Students may declare their majors at the time of entrance, or at the end of Year 1 or Year 2 depending on their abilities.
Social Science: Broad-based admission designed for students interested in pursuing a major in one of the following subjects: Architectural Studies, Economics, Geography and Resource Management, Government and Public Administration, Journalism and Communication, Psychology, Sociology, Urban Studies.
Integrated BBA Programme and Juris Doctor: Students of this double degree programme, for the first four years of study, will pay the University's tuition fee for undergraduate programmes. The year(s) of study beyond the four-year curriculum is offered on a self-financing basis.
- (#3) Accepts Associate Degree holders only.
- (#4) Students must possess knowledge of Chinese and be fluent in Cantonese.
