HSBC Vocational Education Scholarship

Regulations

1. The amount of each scholarship award will be HKD20,000. A selection panel interview to be comprised entirely of HSBC's senior executives will be conducted between March and April 2021*.
2. Scholarships may be awarded to students from disciplines such as accounting, applied science, arts, business administration and management, civil service, childcare and education, computing studies, communication, community care, construction, cultural studies and management, creative media, design, education, early childhood education, environment, engineering, film and cinema, finance, food and nutrition, health science, health care, humanities, human services, hotel and hospitality, information technology, international culinary, language, legal studies, life and leisure, media, nutrition, physical fitness, public administration, recreation, science, social science, social services, social work, textiles, tourism, translation, transport operation, or disciplines as recommended by the Institution as deemed best meet the vocational education training needs in Hong Kong, subject to approval of The Hongkong and Shanghai Banking Corporation Limited ("HSBC").
3. To be eligible for the scholarship, studies must:
 - a) be a Hong Kong permanent resident with the right of abode in Hong Kong;
 - b) be a full-time local Associate Degree student studying in self-financed programmes; and
 - c) have a minimum cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of 3.3 or above, top 10% in class, or equivalent in the first semester of the 2020-21 academic year.
4. Preference will be given to student with disadvantaged backgrounds.
5. Students interested in the Scholarship should contact the Scholarship Coordinator of their Faculty no later than mid-January 2021.

**Due to COVID-19, face-to-face interview sessions have been cancelled this year. No interview will be conducted and candidates will be selected under a paper screening mechanism.*
