



User Guide for Outpatient Medical & Dental Schemes

This User Guide is intended for all students of UOW College Hong Kong

Out-patient Medical Scheme

Coverage

General consultation (including 3 days of basic medication)

1 consultation per day

A maximum of 20 consultations per year

Co-payment: HK\$13/consultation

Procedures

- (a) Student member is required to present the student identity card and HKID card for membership identification at the designated medical clinics.
- (b) Student member is required to make a co-payment of HK\$13/consultation at designated clinic.
- (c) Student member is required to sign on a medical voucher. A copy of the voucher will be returned to the member for record.
- (d) Covered services or treatments will only be provided within the specified working hours of the designated clinics. Any services or treatments provided outside of the specified hours will not be covered and the student member will be responsible for the cost of those services or treatments.

Excluded Conditions and Items

- (a) Specialist consultation and physiotherapy treatment.
- (b) Medical appliances and medication other than that prescribed for necessary medical treatment.
- (c) Hearing aids, prostheses, pacemakers, other expensive medical appliances/equipment.
- (d) Treatment of a cosmetic nature.
- (e) Routine physical examinations, health check-ups or tests not incidental to treatment or diagnosis of sickness or injury or any treatment which is not medically necessary.
- (f) Inoculations and immunization injections. Preventive inoculations, vaccination and immunization.
- (g) Eye glasses and refractions or hearing aids and prescription therefore.
- (h) Psychiatric treatment, functional disorders of the mind and injuries due to insanity or self-infliction.
- (i) Psychological therapy and counselling.
- (j) Pregnancy tests, tests for infertility, or fitting/provision of contraceptive devices and complications arising thereof. Treatment directly or indirectly arising from infertility including in-vitro fertilization or any other artificial method of inducing pregnancy. Female hormonal tests or assays and female hormonal replacement therapy.
- (k) Pregnancy, birth control, sterilization, abortion or any complications arising thereof.
- (l) Suicide, attempted suicide, or intentionally injury whether sane or insane.

- (m) Congenital and chronic illness.
- (n) Medication for any specific anti-viral agents and other expensive new medication and extraordinarily expensive medication.
- (o) Treatment directly or indirectly arising from the abuse of drugs or alcohol.
- (p) Dental care and treatment, except as necessitated by accidental injuries to sound natural teeth wholly.
- (q) Medication supplied on request by the patient but which is not an essential requirement for the treatment of a particular illness.
- (r) Costs incurred as the result of treatment by any person other than a registered medical practitioner.
- (s) Treatment directly or indirectly arising from or consequent upon war, invasion, acts of foreign enemies, hostilities (whether war is declared or not), civil war, rebellion, revolution, insurrection or military or usurped power or terrorist acts, or racing on horses or wheels.

Designated Medical Clinics

Students are required to present the student identity card and HKID card for membership identification at the following designated medical clinics. Advance telephone enquiry is recommended to minimize unnecessary waiting time at the clinic.

Out-patient Dental Scheme

Coverage

Basic dental services*

Co-payment: HK\$98/20-minute session

A maximum of 2 consultations per year

****Basic dental services***

- Routine dental examination (except the first routine dental examination that is free of charge);
- Scaling and polishing in connection with dental examination (maximum of 2 visits per year);
- X-rays;
- Subgingival curettage;
- Emergency dressing;
- Treatment of hemorrhage;
- Fillings with amalgam and for front teeth with composite materials where necessary;
- Extractions – simple extractions, complicated extractions including wisdom teeth and embedded roots accompanied by X-ray;
- Endodontics – root canal therapy and pulpotomy;

Procedures

- (a) Student member is required to make an appointment in advance by calling the designated centres.
- (b) Student member is required to present the student identity card and HKID card for membership identification at designated dental clinics.
- (c) Co-payment of HK\$98/session (20 minutes per session) will be charged to the student member according to the chair-time booked or occupied (whichever is longer). The student member is required to make co-payment upfront at designated clinic.
- (d) Student member is required to sign on a dental treatment form for the designated centre's record.
- (e) Covered services or treatments will only be provided within the specified working hours of the designated clinics. Any service or treatments provided outside of the specified hours will not be covered and the student member will be responsible for the cost of those service or treatments.
