

## **EDB Self-financing Post-secondary Scholarship Scheme 2025-2026**

The Education Bureau (EDB) of the HKSAR Government has, since 2011, set up the Self-financing Post-secondary Scholarship Scheme (SPSS) under the Self-financing Post-secondary Education Fund to establish scholarships and awards to benefit a wide range of students with outstanding academic performance, achievements and talents in non-academic fields as well as with special educational needs. The scholarships and awards are offered to **full time degree**, **sub-degree** (**associate degree and higher diploma**), **and top-up degree** students. The Award aims at equipping students with an international vision, broadening their exposure to multicultural environment and enhancing their communication skills in English, Putonghua or other languages. The Award is not on a reimbursement basis but may cover whole/ part of the expenses incurred during the outreaching activities, such as tuition fees, airfare, accommodation and other incidental expenses.	✓	✓

### **Section C: Application Procedures**

Eligible students wishing to apply for the above scholarships and awards should follow the application procedure:

- 1. Complete the respective Application Form for Nomination ("nomination form"):
  - All forms must be typed; handwritten submissions will not be accepted.
  - Nomination forms are available on the College's website ("Current Student" > "Scholarships and Awards").
- 2. Prepare a single ZIP file of the nomination form and all relevant supporting documents:
  - The completed nomination form and all relevant supporting documents, which should be in Word, PDF or JPG formats, must be <u>combined</u> into a single ZIP File.
  - The ZIP file should be named as "CIU02\_StudentID" (e.g. If your student ID is H10001234, please name your ZIP file as "CIU02\_ H10001234").
