Scholarships for Students with Special Educational Needs 2021-2022

Regulations

The Scholarships for Students with Special Educational Needs is established by Ms Wanda Lau, former Vice President (Academic) of UOW College Hong Kong (UOWCHK), to give recognition to deserving students with special educational needs (SEN) in the pursuit of excellence in academic and other areas.

1. The Awards shall be known as “Scholarships for Students with Special Educational Needs”.
2. There shall be a maximum of 2 award winners and the value of each award shall be HK\$2,500. The maximum amount awarded shall be HK\$5,000 in each academic year.
3. Eligible applicants should be full-time bachelor degree, associate degree, higher diploma or diploma students with SEN* who fulfill the following criteria:
 - a) outstanding performance and achievements in local or international competitions/activities in sports, arts or cultural events (or any other non-academic areas); and
 - b) satisfactory academic performance during the current academic year.
4. Nominations from Faculties of the UOWCHK shall reach their respective Faculty Scholarship Coordinators by the end of January 2022.
5. If no student is found to be of sufficient merits, the award will be withheld in the academic year.
6. Preference will be given to students who have not received a scholarship in UOWCHK before.

**Applicants are required to present documentary proof to support their SEN OR should have already declared his/her SEN at the time of nomination. SEN includes specific learning difficulties, intellectual disabilities, autism spectrum disorders, attention deficit/hyperactivity disorder, physical disability, visual impairment, hearing impairment, speech and language impairment, and mental illness.*
