Academic Improvement Scholarships

Regulations

The Academic Improvement Scholarships have been established by the UOW College Hong Kong (UOWCHK) to encourage students to strive for academic excellence. The regulations for these scholarships are as follows:

- 1. The Scholarships shall be known as "UOWCHK Academic Improvement Scholarship".
- 2. There shall be a maximum of 8 award winners, 2 for each Faculty. The value of each award shall be HK\$6,000. The maximum amount awarded shall be HK\$48,000.
- 3. Eligibility:

Associate degree students

Eligible applicants for the scholarships shall be full-time students pursuing their second year of study who have shown the greatest improvement as reflected in their SGPA of Semester A of Year 2 compared to their CGPA of Year 1 (excluding summer courses). To qualify for this scholarship, the minimum SGPA in any semester must be at least 2.7.

Bachelor degree students

<u>Year 1 Entry</u> - eligible applicants for the scholarships shall be full-time students pursuing their second year of study who have shown the greatest improvements as reflected in their SGPA of Semester A of Year 2 compared to the CGPA of Year 1. To qualify for this scholarship, the minimum SGPA in any semester must be at least 2.7.

- <u>Year 3 Entry</u> eligible applicants for the scholarships shall be full-time students pursuing their fourth year of study who have shown the greatest improvements as reflected in their SGPA of Semester A of Year 4 compared to the CGPA of Year 3. To qualify for this scholarship, the minimum SGPA in any semester must be at least 2.7.
- 4. The Programme Committees of UOWCHK will be responsible for nominating suitable students for the Scholarship. The nominations shall be forwarded to Scholarship Coordinators of individual Faculties by end of January.

- 5. Students who have been awarded this scholarship before will not be nominated again in the same programme of study.
- 6. The Scholarships shall be offered annually until any notice of change is to be received from the UOWCHK by end of August every year.
