Outstanding Student Leader Awards

Regulations

The Outstanding Student Leader Awards have been established by the UOW College Hong Kong (UOWCHK) to recognize the contributions of outstanding student leaders on campus. The regulations for these awards are as follows:

- 1. The Awards shall be known as "UOWCHK Outstanding Student Leader Awards".
- 2. There shall be a maximum of 8 award winners, 2 for each Faculty. Each awardee shall receive HK\$6,000. The maximum amount awarded shall be HK\$48,000.
- 3. Award winners shall be full-time students studying in associate degree Year 2, bachelor degree Year 2 or above (Year 1 entry) or bachelor degree Year 4 (Year 3 entry) and have demonstrated quality leadership in one or more of the following areas:
 - a) The organization and promotion of activities among fellow students at programme, Faculty or College levels;
 - b) Positive image building for UOWCHK; and
 - c) The organization and promotion of art or cultural activities in the campus.

Applications for this award must be submitted together with (i) a completed "Record of Activities for the UOWCHK Outstanding Student Leader Award" which can be found in the "Scholarships and Awards" page of the UOWCHK website, and (ii) a statement on the nature/type of the activity contributing to the participation hours/days signed by the assessor.

- 4. The Awards shall be open for application in January and completed applications should reach Scholarship Coordinators of respective Faculties by end of January. If in any year no student is found to be of sufficient merit, the award will be withheld.
- 5. Students who have been awarded this award before will not be nominated again in the same programme of study.
- 6. The Awards shall be offered annually until any notice of change is to be received from the UOWCHK by the end of August every year.
