

Visit to The Endangered Species Resource Centre @ AFCD



The Faculty of Science and Technology had organized visit to the Endangered Species Resource Centre at the Headquarter of Agriculture, Fisheries and Conservation Department on 15 September 2019.

34 year 1 students from Associate of Science in Environmental Studies (who studied the course "Introduction to Environmental Conservation") joined this activity. This visit aims to achieve CILOs 2 and 3 :



- *Analyse the relationship between human and environment and indicate how human activities influence present and future environmental and conservation management;*
- *Describe the local and international environmental and conservation protection policies and the way in which these are implemented;*



This visit was led by Judy KIU. Students were firstly briefed by the government staff and afterwards, they walked around the centre to explore the facts and law concerned about endangered species.

The Endangered Species Resource Centre occupies an area of about 160 square meters and is located on the sixth floor of Agriculture, Fisheries and Conservation Department headquarters at Cheung Sha Wan Government Offices. This aim of the centre is to teach the knowledge of the endangered

species conservation and their threats due to illegal international trades. Endangered species listed under CITES (Convention on International Trade of Endangered Species of Fauna and Flora) are protected by law in Hong Kong.
